The women's social and economic empowerment component is also considered cross-cutting, strengthening vulnerable families and thier childern in susteneble manner.

- Support the psycho-emotional development of vulnerable youth and girls in the community and schools.
- Create a platform for youth to develop their inner talents and skills, supporting them in pursuing higher education and expanding their employment opportunities.
- Equip targeted families and vulnerable women in the community with micro-business skills for improved livelihoods and sustainable income generation.
- Improve awareness and understanding among schools and the community on gender and gender equality issues and address gender-based violence (GBV) through sensitization and increased awareness of local community structures and direct interventions.

specializes in providing integrated social, economic, and educational services to address the rights of youngsters, youth, and women, ensuring access to economic opportunities, supplementary education, and skill development. Our activities are centered on three pillar:

Education



After-school educational tutorial services

it is for Grade 8, 11, and 12 students, supplementing interactive tutoring in selected subjects in collaboration with local government schools.



Capacity-building training for students

it encompasses study skills and exam management, along with life and social skill development.



Educational Sponsorship

it is for youth, particularly girls from disadvantaged backgrounds, who have completed high school and are enrolled in government or private colleges and universities.



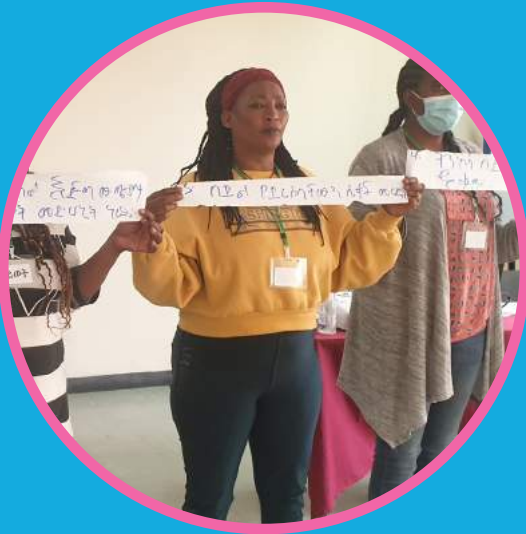
Dignity kits distribution to schoolgirls

to combat period poverty, reduce school dropouts, and facilitate menstrual hygiene management.

Community Development

Psycho-emotional and social skill development services

include interactive training and inspirational sessions for girls and youth from schools and the community to enrich their perspective and motivation.



Community dialogues

address various social issues and bring about change in attitudes and practices through sensitization.



Talent and skill development programs

offering short-term training in ICT, painting, crafts making, and artistic performances such as drama and folk dance for youth with recognized talent.

Women's Social and Economic Empowerment

Training in basic business skills (BBS) for initiating or running small businesses effectively.

Social empowerment components that focus on women's leadership and decision-making skills.

Self-Help Groups: Women who complete BBS training are organized into Self-Help Groups for self-initiation in capital generation and social empowerment.

Provision of in-kind start-ups for women who successfully complete BBS training, enabling them to establish micro-businesses and generate sustainable income for their families.

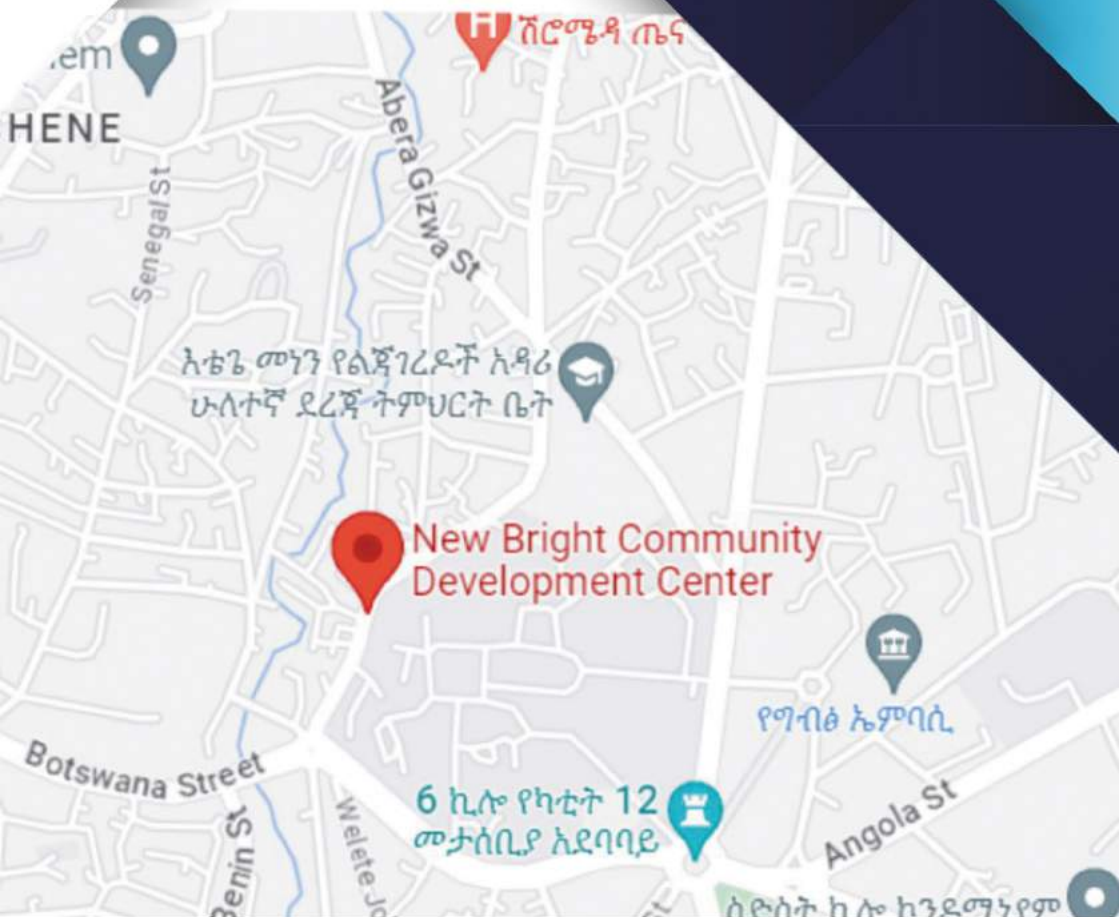
